HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION FOR PRODUCT

EMERGENCY and FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth well with water. Drink large quantities of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention.

Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Skin: Flush with plenty of water.

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE (Acute and Chronic)

Inhalation: May cause irritation of upper respiratory tract.

Ingestion: May cause burning in mouth and esophagus; nausea and vomiting. Glycol ether has a toxic effect on the red blood cells.

Eyes: May cause irritation to eyes.

Skin: May cause irritation.

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

Steps to be taken upon release or spillage (including neutralizing):

With large spills, dyke for later disposal. Neutralize with diluted acid - like hydrochloric or sulfuric acid. Minor spills can be neutralized and flushed with plenty of water.

Waste disposal method:

Waste product should not be discharged into sewers or streams. It should be first neutralized with dilute acid and then discharged according to federal, local and provincial regulations.

Handling and Storage Requirements:

Store in cool area above freezing point of product.

Ventilation Requirements (Local or General):

General ventilation is usually sufficient.

Respiratory Protection:

Not normally necessary.

Eye Protection:

Chemical Workers goggles.

Other Protection:

Rubber, vinyl or neoprene gloves and coveralls should be worn to prevent contact with skin and clothing.
